Windstorm Christian, which affected Western and Northern Europe on October 27-29, caused EUR 994 million (\$1357.5 million) in insured losses, according to an initial estimate from PERILS.

The independent industry-wide catastrophe insurance data organization said the majority of the losses occurred in Denmark, Germany and the Netherlands, with Belgium, Sweden and the UK also incurring losses.

In a statement on Friday, December 6, PERILS said the estimate is based on ultimate gross loss data reported by primary insurance companies and excludes losses indemnified by government schemes.

PERILS will provide an updated estimate on January 27, 2014, three months after the event start date.
